

COLORADO LOTTERY COMMISSION  
Minutes of Public Hearing  
July 14, 2004

The Public Hearing (via videoconference) was called to order by Chair Hess at 9:07 a.m. on July 14, 2004, at the Pueblo Lottery Office. Present in the Pueblo Lottery Office were Chair Stephen Hess; Commissioners Betty Martinez, Micheal Acree and Timothy Bachicha; Michael Cooke, Executive Director of the Department of Revenue; Peggy Gordon, Director; Phil Bauer, Brad Mohs, Terry Patterson, and Topper Wilson of Scientific Games International; Kathy Jump and Robert Doyle of GTECH Corporation; Marci Bachicha; and members of the Lottery staff. Present in the Denver Lottery Office were Commissioner Joan Ringel; Tom Kitts, Deputy Director; Michael Santisi, Assistant Deputy Attorney General; Jeanne Barish and Brent Voge of the Department of Revenue; Paul Louderman of Karsh and Hagan Communications; Toben Molica, of Scientific Games International; Jessica Kirscht of Kirscht Associates; and members of the Lottery staff.

Chair Hess began the public hearing by introducing Commissioner Betty Martinez. Commissioner Martinez gave a brief overview of her background. She stated that she is a local businesswoman; she owns a real estate and mortgage company. Commissioner Martinez is a native of Pueblo.

Chair Hess next called for the Election of Chair and Vice-Chair for fiscal year 2004-2005. Chair Hess made a motion to nominate Commissioner Acree for Chair and Commissioner Bachicha for Vice-Chair, as a slate. Chair Hess inquired if there were any other nominations; there were none. The nomination passed unanimously. Both were congratulated by their fellow Commissioners and Lottery staff. Chair Acree thanked everyone for supporting him as Commissioner for the past six years. He welcomed Commissioner Martinez, and thanked Commissioner Hess for his leadership, commitment and dedication during the last year.

Chair Acree called for the items on the Public Hearing Agenda. He requested that Product Manager Lee Burnett present the Rules.

The first Rule reviewed by Product Manager Lee Burnett was Permanent Rule 10.A, Lotto, as Amended. Mr. Burnett stated staff would like to request the adoption of this rule for the purpose of updating information pertaining to subscription play and advance play.

The next Rule reviewed by Mr. Burnett was Rule 10.D, Cash 5, as Amended. He stated staff would like to request the adoption of this rule for the purpose of updating information pertaining to advance play. Commissioner Hess made a motion to approve and adopt Permanent Rules 10.A, Lotto, as Amended and

Rule 10.D, Cash 5, as Amended. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chair Bachicha. Chair Acree inquired if there were any comments from the public. There were none. The motion passed unanimously.

The next Rules reviewed by Mr. Burnett were Permanent Rules 6.QE, 7-11-21, Game No. 276; Rule 6.QF, \$25,000 Hot Slots, Game No. 277; 6.QG, Golden Ticket, Game No. 278; Rule 6.QH, Cash Flurry, Game No. 279; and Rule 6.QI, Extreme Green, Game No. 280. He described the features of the games, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the games. Vice-Chair Bachicha made a motion to approve and adopt Permanent Rules 6.QE, 7-11-21, Game No. 276; Rule 6.QF, \$25,000 Hot Slots, Game No. 277; 6.QG, Golden Ticket, Game No. 278; Rule 6.QH, Cash Flurry, Game No. 279; and Rule 6.QI, Extreme Green, Game No. 280 contingent upon the approval and adoption of the drawing guidelines for Extreme Green, Game No. 280 at the August 11, 2004 Commission Meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hess. Chair Acree inquired if there were any comments from the public. There were none. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Burnett next stated staff was requesting approval of the following Rules to be repealed: Rule 6.LX, Super Duper Doubler, Game No. 164; Rule 6.MO, Tic Tac Toe, Game No. 182; Rule 6.MT, Crossword Xtra, Game No. 187; Rule 6.NC, Super 7s, Game No. 196; Rule 6.NI, Just A Buck, Game No. 202; Rule 6.OD, Lucky 13, Game 223, and Rule 6.OG, Holiday Wishes, Game No. 226. Commissioner Hess made a motion to approve the following Rules to be repealed: Rule 6.LX, Super Duper Doubler, Game No. 164; Rule 6.MO, Tic Tac Toe, Game No. 182; Rule 6.MT, Crossword Xtra, Game No. 187; Rule 6.NC, Super 7s, Game No. 196; Rule 6.NI, Just A Buck, Game No. 202; Rule 6.OD, Lucky 13, Game 223, and Rule 6.OG, Holiday Wishes, Game No. 226. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chair Bachicha. Chair Acree inquired if there were any comments from the public. There were none. The motion passed unanimously.

Chair Acree inquired if there were any comments from the public. There were none.

There being no further business to come before the Public Hearing, Chair Acree adjourned the Public Hearing at 9:23 a.m.
