

COLORADO LOTTERY COMMISSION
Minutes of Public Hearing
January 8, 2003

The Public Hearing was called to order by Chair Javonni Willis at 9:05 a.m. on January 8, 2003, at the Denver Lottery Office. Chair Willis next called for the items on the Public Hearing Agenda. At the request of Director Zamarripa, Website Coordinator, Bev Saidel presented the Rules.

The first Rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.MZ, Winner Take All, Game No. 193. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game.
