

COLORADO LOTTERY COMMISSION  
Minutes of Public Hearing  
May 14, 2003

The Public Hearing was called to order by Chair Javonni Willis at 9:05 a.m. on May 14, 2003, at the Pueblo Lottery Office. Present via telephone conference was Commissioner Michael Bennet. Present in person were Chair Javonni Willis; Vice-Chair Stephen Hess, and Commissioner Timothy Bachicha; Mark Zamarripa, Director; Kathy Jones, Deputy Director; Vickie Robb, Administration Director; Tom Thornburg, Security Director; Dan Noreen, Marketing Director; Maurice Knaizer, Deputy Attorney General; Janine Whiteman, Toben Molica, and Ted Parianos of Scientific Games International; Phyllis Mendoza of GTECH Corporation; Paul Louderman of Karsh and Hagan; Janet Colbert and Nancy Sparks of Qwest; and members of the Lottery staff.

Chair Willis called for the items on the Public Hearing Agenda. At the request of Director Zamarripa, Website Coordinator, Bev Saidel presented the Rules.

The first Rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.NT, Pirate's Cove, Game No. 213. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as a Permanent Rule.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.NU, 7-11-21, Game No. 214. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as a Permanent Rule.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.NW, Pink Panther, Game No. 216. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as a Permanent Rule.

Vice-Chair Hess made a motion to approve and adopt Permanent Rules 6.NT, Pirate's Cove, Game No. 213; 6.NU, 7-11-21, Game No. 214; and 6.NW, Pink Panther, Game No. 216. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bachicha and passed unanimously.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Emergency and Permanent Rule 6.NS, Adventure Island, Game No. 212, as Amended and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NS. She described the features

of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as an Emergency and Permanent Rule, as Amended and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NS.

Commissioner Bachicha made a motion to approve and adopt Emergency and Permanent Rule 6.NS, Adventure Island, Game No. 212 as Amended and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NS. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chair Hess and passed unanimously.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Emergency Rule 14.A Powerball as Amended and Resolution Concerning Rule 14.A. Ms. Saidel stated the Multi-State Lottery Association (MUSL) adopted the amended rules clarifying the Match Five Bonus Prize on March 5, 2003. By adopting the rule today, Powerball Rule 14 will be in agreement with the MUSL Rule. She stated the Amended Permanent Rule will be presented for adoption at the June 11, 2003 Commission Meeting. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as an Emergency Rule and Resolution Concerning Rule 14.A.

Vice-Chair Hess made a motion to approve and adopt Emergency Rule 14.A Powerball as Amended and Resolution Concerning Rule 14.A. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bachicha and passed unanimously.

Ms. Saidel next stated staff was requesting approval to repeal Rule 3, Rights of Licensees. Commissioner Bachicha made a motion to approve the repeal of Rule 3, Rights of Licensees. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chair Hess and passed unanimously.

Ms. Saidel next stated staff was requesting approval to repeal the following Rules: Rule 10.B, Keno; Rule 10.E, Hot Dice; Rule 10.F, Tic Tac Dough; Rule 10.G, Football Fortune; Rule 10.H, Holiday Bucks; Rule 10.I, Colorado Riches; Rule 12.A, Charity Drawing; and Rule 12.B, Shop Like a Lotto Winner.

Vice-Chair Hess made a motion to approve the repeal of the following Rules: Rule 10.B, Keno; Rule 10.E, Hot Dice; Rule 10.F, Tic Tac Dough; Rule 10.G, Football Fortune; Rule 10.H, Holiday Bucks; Rule 10.I, Colorado Riches; Rule 12.A, Charity Drawing; and Rule 12.B, Shop Like a Lotto Winner. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bennet and passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Public Hearing, Chair Willis adjourned the Public Hearing at 9:17 a.m.
