

COLORADO LOTTERY COMMISSION  
Minutes of Public Hearing  
October 16, 2002

The Public Hearing was called to order by Vice-Chair Stephen Hess at 9:10 a.m. on October 16, 2002, at the Pueblo Lottery Office. Present via telephone conference were Chair Javonni Willis and Commissioners Micheal Acree and Timothy Bachicha (Commissioner Bachicha joined the meeting at approximately 9:15). Present in person were Vice-Chair Stephen Hess, and Commissioner Michael Bennet. Mark Zamarripa, Director; Kathy Jones, Deputy Director; Vickie Robb, Lottery Administration Director; Tom Thornburg, Lottery Security Director; Dan Noreen, Marketing Director; Perry King, Internal Auditor; Maurice Knaizer, Deputy Attorney General; Michael Santisi, Assistant Deputy Attorney General; Pocky Marranzino and Paul Louderman of Karsh and Hagan; Phyllis Mendoza and Jack Schaffer of GTECH; Toben Molica of Scientific Games International; Pete Webb and Krista DeSabato of Peter Webb Public Relations; and members of the Lottery staff.

Vice-Chair Hess called for the items on the Public Hearing Agenda. At the request of Director Zamarripa, Website Coordinator, Bev Saidel presented the Rules.

The first Rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.MO, Tic Tac Toe, Game No. 182. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as a Permanent Rule.

The next Rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.MT, Crossword Xtra, Game No. 187. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as a Permanent Rule.

Drawing Manager Jon Mullett next presented the drawing guidelines for Crossword Xtra, Game No. 187 and Tic Tac Toe, Game No. 182. He reviewed the entry mechanism, eligibility, prizes, drawing dates, times and locations, and drawing procedures.

Commissioner Bachicha made a motion to adopt Permanent Rule 6.MO, Tic Tac Toe, Game No. 182 and Drawing Guidelines for Tic

Tac Toe. The motion was seconded by Chair Willis and passed unanimously.

Commissioner Bennet made a motion to adopt Permanent Rule 6.MT, Crossword Xtra, Game No. 187 and Drawing Guidelines for Crossword Xtra. The motion was seconded by Chair Willis and passed unanimously.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.MU, Lucky Loot, Game No. 188. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as a Permanent Rule.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.MV, Cash Corral, Game No. 189. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as a Permanent Rule.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.MW, Die Another Day, Game No. 190 and Resolution Concerning Emergency Rule 6.MW. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. She stated the reason for the emergency rule was to coordinate the game launch date with the release of the movie in theaters. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as a Permanent Rule and Resolution Concerning Emergency Rule 6.MW.

Chair Willis made a motion to adopt Permanent Rule 6.MU, Lucky Loot, Game No. 188, Permanent Rule 6.MV, Cash Corral, Game No. 189, Permanent Rule 6.MW, Die Another Day, Game No. 190 and Resolution Concerning Emergency Rule 6.MW. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bachicha and passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Public Hearing, Vice-Chair Hess adjourned the Public Hearing at 9:17 a.m.
