

COLORADO LOTTERY COMMISSION  
Minutes of Public Hearing  
April 23, 2003

The Public Hearing was called to order by Chair Javonni Willis at 9:00 a.m. on April 23, 2003, at the Pueblo Convention Center, 320 Central Main Street, Pueblo, Colorado. Present were Chair Javonni Willis; Vice-Chair Stephen Hess, and Commissioner's Micheal Acree, Timothy Bachicha and Michael Bennet; Mark Zamarripa, Director; Kathy Jones, Deputy Director; Vickie Robb, Administration Director; Tom Thornburg, Security Director; Dan Noreen, Marketing Director; Maurice Knaizer, Deputy Attorney General; Janine Whiteman and Toben Molica of Scientific Games International; Dennis Miller of Oberthur Gaming Technology; Paul Louderman of Karsh and Hagan; Phyllis Mendoza and Robert Doyle of GTECH Corporation; and members of the Lottery staff.

Chair Willis inquired, via telephone conference, whether members of the public were present at the Pueblo Lottery Office for the Public Hearing. Program Assistant Alysia Ivan responded that no one from the public was present for the Public Hearing.

Chair Willis next called for the items on the Public Hearing Agenda. At the request of Director Zamarripa, Website Coordinator, Bev Saidel presented the Rules.

The first Rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.NI, Just a Buck, Game No. 202. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as a Permanent Rule.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.NJ, Mega Bucks, Game No. 203. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as a Permanent Rule.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Permanent Rule 6.NK, Bonus Blackjack, Game No. 204. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. and 6.NK, Bonus Blackjack, Game No. 204. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Acree and passed unanimously.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Emergency and Permanent Rule 6.MY, Cash Cards, Game No. 192, as Amended and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.MY. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as an Emergency and Permanent Rule, as Amended and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.MY.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Emergency and Permanent Rule 6.MZ, Winner Take All, Game No. 193, as Amended and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.MZ. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as an Emergency and Permanent Rule, as Amended and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.MZ.

Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as an Emergency and Permanent Rule, and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NQ.

The next rule reviewed by Ms. Saidel was Emergency and Permanent Rule 6.NR, 7-11-21, Game No. 211, and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NR. She described the features of the game, including the play style, the prize amounts, the number of times players may win on a ticket, the number of tickets ordered, and the projected launch date for the game. Ms. Saidel further stated staff was requesting adoption as an Emergency and Permanent Rule, and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NR.

Vice-Chair Hess made a motion to adopt Emergency and Permanent Rule 6.MY, Cash Cards, Game No. 192 as Amended and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.MY; Rule 6.MZ, Winner Take All, Game No. 193 as Amended and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.MZ; Rule 6.NL, HULK, Game No. 205 and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NL; Rule 6.NM, Bingo, Game No. 206 and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NM; Rule 6.NN, Match 3, Game No. 207 and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NN; Rule 6.NO, The Money Game, Game No. 208 and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NO; Rule 6.NP, Fun 1s, Game No. 209 and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NP; Rule 6.NQ, Four Leaf Fortune, Game No. 210 and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NQ; and Rule 6.NR, 7-11-21, Game No. 211 and Resolution Concerning Rule 6.NR. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bennet and passed unanimously.

Ms. Saidel next stated staff was requesting approval of the following Rules to be repealed: Rule 6.KT, Bonus Card, Game No. 134; Rule 6.LE, Bonus Crossword, Game No. 146; Rule 6.LR, Crazy 8s, Game No. 159; and Rule 7, 7a, 7b, 7c, and 7d Distribution of Proceeds.

Commissioner Bennet made a motion to adopt the following Rules to be repealed: Rule 6.KT, Bonus Card, Game No. 134; Rule 6.LE, Bonus Crossword, Game No. 146; Rule 6.LR, Crazy 8s, Game No. 159; and Rule 7, 7a, 7b, 7c, and 7d Distribution of

Proceeds. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Acree and passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Public Hearing, Chair Willis adjourned the Public Hearing at 9:15 a.m.
